


MultiPM – Cleaning the sample inlet

- 1- Tools you need
 - 1 wrench 9/16" and 1 wrench ½"
 - A soft cloth and a soft pipe cleaning brush
- 2- Turn off and unplug the airpointer. Locate the MultiPM inlet and unscrew the connector to the heater.



- 3- Unscrew the 1/4" Stainless steel connector and remove the sample inlet from the airpointer
- 4- Disconnect the TSP head from the inlet

- 5- Clean carefully the TSP head with a moist smooth cloth inside and outside
- 6- Check the inlet tube and if necessary, clean the inner surface with a soft brush or a soft cloth
- 7- Reassemble the sample inlet, screw it back to the airpointer, and reconnect the heater
